Greenbank Sports Links Programme

Over the past few months, we have set up the 'Greenbank Sports Links Programme' which has involved hockey, netball, golf and rugby sessions for Greenbank pupils with sports coaches. The aim of the programme is to provide a much-needed link from school to local clubs so pupils are encouraged to continue their love of sport outside of the school environment.

The opportunity has arisen to extend this programme to Year 7&8 netball and all years for badminton. The netball would be taken by Ann Tuft who is already working with the Year 9&10 pupils very successfully. It will run on a Monday evening from 5.45pm-6.45pm for a five week block in Greenbank's sports hall. The badminton coaching will be taken by Mr Bentzen who is a teacher at Greenbank and a highly qualified badminton coach who has previously worked with our Gifted and talented badminton players when training for a European schools competition. He is a member of Victoria Hall badminton

This is an exciting opportunity for our pupils to work with specialist coaches who can also provide advice on the next step to joining a club on a more regular basis. The 'Greenbank Sports Links Programme' will cost £10 per activity for a 5 week programme. These activities do have a limited capacity and the first enrolment fee is due before the first session, payable via Parentpay.

Sessions will run on the dates below:

Netball – Monday 10th June – Monday 8th July

Badminton – Tuesday 11th June – Tuesday 9th July

Netball: Ann Tuft is a qualified Level Two UKCC England Netball Coach and has run Formby Netball Club for over 12 years. She is involved in Merseyside County Netball Academy and has coached the Development and U13 Academy Squads for the past four years to help prepare athletes to reach the next level of the England Pathway.

Badminton: Mr Bentzen is a member of staff at Greenbank. He is a qualified Level 2 coach for Badminton England. He has represented Lancashire in the county championships. He currently plays for Victoria Hall BC in the Southport League. Victoria Hall is looking to build a junior section which would play on a Friday evening at Greenbank.
