Humanities/Geography Study Visit to Iceland - October 2020

The Geography department are delighted to offer your daughter the opportunity to participate in a 4 night residential trip to Iceland. We foresee that this will be a wonderful trip for your daughter with exciting opportunities which will both assist with her studies in Geography and offer her the chance to gain amazing experiences.

The proposed dates for the trip are **Saturday 24th October 2020 to Wednesday 28th 2020**, during October half term. Travel to Iceland will be by air. The trip will be extremely beneficial for students who have a particular interest in physical Geography. The cost will be approximately **£850.00 per student**, depending on numbers and response this cost may be subject to change.

This cost is based upon the following;

- Half board accommodation

- Visit to Reykjavik
- 3 x Full Day National Guide
- Visit to Hellisheidi Power Plant
- One piece of checked-in hold luggage per person each way.

The trip is organised through NST, which is fully bonded member of ABTA, ensuring both financial protection and high standards of professionalism and reliability.

The first payment will be requested once the places have been filled and subsequent payment schedule will follow when provided by the travel company. All payments made will be non-refundable as the costs will have been incurred by the school.

This opportunity will, without doubt, be a valuable and memorable educational experience. However, it is important that student are aware that the highest standards of behaviour are expected. This is vitally important for the success of the trip and their own safety.
