### Year Group Visits

LANGUAGES - Year 7 - Boulogne, France in June 2020 (approx. cost per student £200) – Letter due out this week (Usually runs annually)  
HUMANITIES - Year 9 – Poland – July 2020 - (approx. cost £550 per student) – Trip full  
MATHEMATICS - Year 9 - London trip Thursday 9<sup>th</sup> July - Saturday 11<sup>th</sup> July 2020 (approx. cost per student £260) – Trip full (has run biannually)  
SCIENCE - Year 10 – CERN (The European Organisation for Nuclear Research) and United Nations – Geneva, Switzerland – July 2020 – (approx. cost £370 per student) - places still available (usually runs annually)  
SCIENCE - Year 10 – Berlin – (approx. cost per student £450) July 2020 – places still available (has run for two consecutive years)  
PASTORAL - Year 11 Biannual Trip to partner school in Ghana (February 2020) (approx. cost per student £1200 - 1500 (pupils raise funds themselves through bag packing and cake sales) – Trip full

### Duke of Edinburgh Award Scheme

Annual Duke of Edinburgh Award Scheme (Year 9) – Bronze - £125 – 2020 for registrations and expeditions – (Information will be sent out shortly)  
Annual Duke of Edinburgh Award Scheme (Year 10) – Silver - £160 for registration and expeditions (Information will be sent out shortly)

### Mixed Year Groups

LANGUAGES - Malaga Yr 9&10 October 2019 visit – (approx. cost per student £560) – trip full (usually runs biannually)  
LANGUAGES - Lille trip Yr 9&10 December 2020 (approx. cost per student £270) – trip likely to run and information be sent out in October 2020 (usually runs biannually)  
PHYSICAL EDUCATION - Year 7, 8 and 9 – PGL Shropshire visit May 2020 (approx. cost per student £185) – trip full (usually runs annually)  
PHYSICAL EDUCATION - Ski Trip to Austria – March 2021 (approx. cost per student £1340) – trip full (usually runs biannually)  
MUSIC - Music Tour to Amsterdam - April 2020 – (approx. cost per student £550) – trip full (usually runs biannually)  
PHYSICAL EDUCATION - Netball Greece Yrs 7-9 (approx. cost per student £750) – places available  
HUMANITIES - Iceland current Yrs 9&10 October 2020 (approx. cost per student £850)  
PHYSICAL EDUCATION – ALL YEARS - Wimbledon – July 2020 – (approx. Cost per student £200) – no information has been sent out yet.

## **Funding**

Parents will be expected to fund visits by meeting the payment plan that is outlined by the Group Leader. All deposits are non-refundable. Payments can be made via Parentpay.

Educational Visits are partially subsidised for pupils in receipt of Pupil Premium Funding  
All educational visits are planned, risk assessed and evaluated using the Sefton Evolve system.
